

Wrexham Donation Guide

Wrexham Foodbank

What can I donate? Non-perishable in-date food (e.g. tins/packets). Toiletries (no ladies sanitary products at this time thank you). Nappies. To find out what items are specifically needed email info@wrexham.foodbank.org.uk or call 07538 547971.

Where can I donate? Unit 1a, Puleston Industrial Estate, Ruabon Road, LL13 7RF. Open Tuesdays and Fridays 10-3. Permanent collection points also based in Tesco, Asda and Sainsburys.

Where will it go? Three-day food parcels are given to local people in crisis who have been referred to the Foodbank by frontline professionals such as the Job Centre, Citizen's Advice Bureau, doctors, teachers, housing officers, probation workers, and most local charities and organisations. Nappies are also distributed through the Baby Essentials project to those referred by professionals such as Health Visitors.

WINGS

What can I donate? WINGS Wrexham is currently ceasing the use of its sanitary product donation boxes given the funding stream for Period Dignity from the Welsh Government.

Where can I donate? Purchased from Welsh Government funding, the range of sanitary products are stored at the Foodbank warehouse and distributed via the WINGS Wrexham team.

Where will it go? WINGS Wrexham is a partner organisation of the Foodbank and is working with the referral and support agencies across the borough to ensure that WINGS boxes of free sanitary products are placed where there is a need such as at the Foodbank centres and other local organisations. The WINGS Wrexham team will replenish supplies.

Given to Shine

What can I donate? Surplus fresh food that would otherwise go to landfill. Re-usable nappies and ladies' sanitary products.

Where can I donate? Contact the group via their Facebook page.

Where will it go? Deliveries are made to local people who make a request online.

The Salvation Army

What can I donate? Toiletries. Clothing suitable for those attending the Drop In (e.g. socks, warm coats). Sleeping bags (no bedding thank you).

Where can I donate? The Salvation Army, Garden Road, Rhosddu, LL11 2NU. Open Monday to Friday 9.30-4.30.

Where will it go? Local people in crisis who attend the weekly Drop In Breakfast.

Ty Croeso

What can I donate? Socks, underpants, knickers, toiletries.

Where can I donate? Ty Croeso, 31 Grosvenor Road. Opening hours are 9am-11am Monday to Wednesday, Thursday and Friday 4.30pm - 6.30pm, Saturday Sunday 10.30am - 12.30pm.

Where will it go? Ty Croeso is a drop-in service which supports people who are experiencing homelessness and also have a substance misuse issue.

Ty Nos

What can I donate? Men's/Women's clothes (boxers, socks, tee shirts, jeans, joggers, jumpers, coats, trainers), toiletries, sleeping bags, single duvets.

Where can I donate? Ty Nos, Holt Road, LL13 8NE after 7pm any evening; during the day donations can be dropped off at The Foyer, 43 Crescent Road, LL13 8HF.

Where will it go? Ty Nos is a 16-bed project for single homeless men and women over 18 years old. It's open on a nightly basis from 8pm to 8am 365 days of the year, operates on a first come first served rule with priority given to people with a local connection.

Cais Soup Dragon

What can I donate? Men's/women's underwear, socks, toiletries, sleeping bags. No bedding thank you.

Where can I donate? Donations can be dropped off between 10.30 -5pm Monday - Friday, 65 King Street, Wrexham. LL11 1HR.

Where will it go? The Soup Dragon provides food for homeless and roofless people between 5pm and 6pm on a Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday, and between 4pm and 5pm on Thursday. Weekend Provision Sat 12 - 4pm, Sun 11 - 3pm.

Home-Start Baby Equipment Bank

What can I donate? Highchairs, baby baths, Moses baskets, cots, junior beds, stairgates, prams, pushchairs, bath supports, bouncy chairs.

Where can I donate? Contact Home-Start on 01978 266660 or babybankwrexham@gmail.com

Where will it go? Local people who have been referred to the service by organisations working with them.
